Accessible Parking (5)



We have several options for accessible parking at our park. Reserved parking is available and clearly marked in the main car park for guests whose vehicle displays a Disability Parking Permit. Our entrance is a 300 metre walk from this area. Additional carparking is also available outside Farmstay Reception (follow signs to Farmstay from the main carpark) and is clearly marked.

Public Transport

Public bus facilities are available to Warner Bros. Movie World and Wet'n'Wild. Paradise Country is approximately 2km from the bus station. Translink can provide details regarding bus and train transport to and from the park. Taxis are available from the main carpark. Guests should visit Guest Services for bookings. Gold Coast Cabs have vehicles which cater for guests using wheelchairs.

Admission

Entrance

Our entrance is located 300 metres from the main carpark. Follow the signs to the Homestead for entry to the park.

Admission Price

Discounted single day entry admission rates are available upon presentation of a State or Commonwealth issued Disability Pension Card.

Please present this card to the cashier when purchasing admission tickets to obtain the discounted rate

Companion & Carer Admission

Guests who produce a Companion Card (companioncard.gov.au) are entitled to one (1) free of charge Companion Ticket so that their companion can provide care and support during the visit. Guests who produce a Carer's Card (or similar) issued by relevant State or Commonwealth authorities (as opposed to a Companion Card) will be entitled to a discounted admission rate.

Companion & Carer Assistance

Some shows, animal presentations and animal interactive experiences can be held in areas with stadium seating and around or inside animal exhibits. We recommend that guests with carers or companions notify our friendly Guest Services team prior to attending shows, presentations or booking an animal experience so we can ensure you have the best experience possible. Unfortunately, our team members are not able to physically assist guests nor are they available to accompany guests for the duration of the day or act as a companion for animal interactives

Food & Retail

We have several wheelchair accessible food and retail outlets at our park. We are able to accommodate most dietary requirements at The Farmhouse Restaurant (location E3) and the Burrow café (location G4). To ensure our chefs are best prepared for your visit, please contact Guest Services prior to arriving at the park or on your day of visit.

First Aid

Registered Nurses staff the First Aid Office (location H6). Personal medical equipment (e.g. ventilators and personal medication requiring refrigeration) may be stored and used at First Aid. Please note First Aid does not supply equipment for everyday use.

Assistance Animals

Paradise Country welcomes registered assistance animals around the majority of the park's precincts. In an effort to maintain positive animal welfare for our animals, there are some animal exhibits, presentations, and animal experiences that are unsuitable for assistance animals to be in close proximity to. Our friendly Guest Services team can provide you with an accessible park map and can assist you in planning your day. Upon arrival, please notify guest services (located immediately next to the admissions desk) that you have an assistance animal so our team can assist you with your visit.

Baby Change Tables

Changing facilities are located in the homestead restroom (location D3) and Farmstay Reception restrooms (location H6).

Restrooms

We have several amenities areas that accommodate wheelchair access.

Their locations are:

- Homestead (location D3)
- Farmstay reception (location H6)
- Adventure Camp (location F2)

We have additional amenities for companion or carers to utilise. This restroom is available at First Aid (location H5).

Wheelchair & Stroller Hire

We have several manual wheelchairs and strollers for our guests to hire at Guest Services. Wheelchairs are complimentary however a refundable deposit is required to be paid upon collection. So we can ensure a wheelchair is available to hire for your visit, please pre-book by calling Guest Services on (07) 5588 1607.

Shaun's Scraps and Taps

Interactive kids waterplay area. Attraction is not suitable for guests with pre-existing limb injuries or guests with physical limitations that could be aggravated by sudden movements. Accessible access for wheelchairs and prams. Please contact Guest Services for further information.

The Pig's Playground

Playground featuring slide and climbing activities. Attraction is not suitable for guests with back, neck or similar conditions. Attraction is not suitable for guests with pre-existing limb injuries or guests with physical limitations that could be aggravated by sudden movements. Please contact Guest Services for further information.

Animal Exhibits

Wildlife Walkthrough, Farmyard Nursery, Farmyard Play Paddock, Dingo Den, Wombat, Meerkat, Marmoset and the Global Conservation Centre. Accessible access is available to all animal exhibits.

Animal Encounters and Wildlife Photos

To ensure the safety of our guests and animals, our animal encounters and wildlife photo opportunities have strict participation criteria. We recommend contacting our friendly Guest Services Team to discuss what animal experience is best suited to you prior to making a booking with us.
